Qualifications and Requirements:

- Must reside in Southern CA region (preferably Pasadena-Foothills region for your commuting convenience to attend in-person sessions with the instructor)
- Four-year college degree preferred (min. 2yrs of college required; must include successful completion of at least one English course and some general education courses)
- Access to laptop and WiFi (laptop needed to complete "hands-on" assignments during work sessions with the author and onsite at nonprofit organizations)
- Proficient with basic use of MSWord (typing speed of approx. 50 wpm or willing to improve keyboarding skills)
- Familiar with MSExcel (for creating budgets) or willing to learn
- Available to schedule and participate in (unpaid) initial training/orientation period of 4-6 weeks (min. 160 hours to approx. 200 hours)
- Personal transportation (to attend in-person trainings with the author; some trainings may involve working onsite at nonprofits in the LA-area to participate in interviews/meetings)
- Ability to conduct basic searches on the internet to locate information
- Ability to work independently to complete follow-up learning activities
- Enjoy reading and learning new things
- Strong command of the written English language
- Understand the importance of follow-through and meeting deadlines

The Internship Training Program includes:

- An overview of **nonprofits and 501(c)(3)** charitable tax-exempt organizations
- How to conduct **grants research** using the internet and other free resources
- How to create a **program design** to illustrate/describe the program or services that need to be funded
- How to create annual budgets and project budgets (for a nonprofit or other organizations)
- How to review a funder's **grant guidelines** and **grant application** instructions
- How to gather and/or create the 10 basic building blocks needed to write any type of grant
- How to **complete and submit grants** to government, foundation and corporate funding sources (online and hardcopy)
